

### BACKSTAGE:

A separate room for the band to get some rest before and after the show.

It would be great to have some chairs and shower.

## SLEEP:

A warm, clean, dark and quiet accommodation for 6 persons with mattresses, bath room and shower. A safe parking space near the sleeping accommodation should be available.

# **MERCHANDISE:**

A table of approx. 1.5m length and a small light or some candles for our merchandising in the same room as the show, if possible and if someone of the organization is ok to sell our merchandise, let's find an arrangement.
